

Alex Potratz Memorial Scholarship

Criteria:

The Alex Potratz Memorial Scholarship is available to students attending a four year college or university, two year college, community college, or technical school.

Any student who is a 2014 N-P graduate and will attend an aforementioned institution is eligible to apply for this scholarship.

Award of this scholarship shall be based on involvement in religious and community service activities, volunteer activities, personal character and academic achievement. Please note – community, religious and volunteer activities need not be limited to the Nashua-Plainfield School District. If you attend church in a different town, or open enroll and are active in your own community, such activities are also acceptable.

One scholarship in the amount of \$500 will be available.

The scholarship recipient is to use the funds for books and/or tuition.

The scholarship recipient will be determined by the family of Alex Potratz.

Presentation of the Alex Potratz Memorial Scholarship will be at the Nashua-Plainfield graduation ceremony. The scholarship funds will be forwarded to the student's account at the institution the recipient plans to attend.
