The \$500 scholarship is being offered to a senior entering the field of education. The applicants are to possess good moral character, be ambitious and industrious, and have good leadership ability. The scholarship will be presented at the Nashua-Plainfield graduation ceremonies.

- * The scholarship recipient must demonstrate community involvement as shown in their application.
- * The application will be determined by The Szalkowski Family and a committee of Nashua-Plainfield staff. Each applicant will write an essay that will be evaluated for clarity and content development. The committee will also consider student involvement and academic achievement.
- * Attach a resume with your name, address, and GPA at Nashua-Plainfield High School. List the activities you have participated inside and outside of school that have been a benefit to your community. List any leadership positions in school clubs, sports, a list of community activities performed, and the name of the college you plan to attend.
- * Type a 250 or less word essay responding to the following question: How your community has influenced your personal development and how have you developed your community?
- * Attach a current high school transcript.
- * The scholarship application is due to Mr. Morris by April 11, 2014.
